History

PAVE project was initially contributed in 2009 by SAP. The project was first demonstrated on Eclipse Summit Europe 2009 event.

Pave is a framework for chaining existing Web Tools Project operations that use Data Model Framework for more complicated scenarios. It is built with the idea of easily reusing any UI and operations. For instance one of the samples that we have submitted ("pattern") will take a bunch of JPA Entities figure out the dependencies between them, generate a single Session CRUD Facade and build JSF facade on-top of it. In the example the pattern (sequence of operations) reuses the Session bean creation wizard pages and operations and dynamic web project operations chaining them directly without any modifications.

Reasons for the Termination

Unfortunately the project could not attract attention from adopters or interesting parties. Pave quickly slowed down it's development. The project latest working version based on Eclipse Helios release(2010). There is no commit activity for more than a year now.
